



Statement of Commitment to Child Safety

Rainbow Ridge School for Steiner Education is a Child Safe Organisation which welcomes all children and their families.

We are committed to providing environments where our students are safe and feel safe, where their participation is valued, their views are respected, and their voices are heard about decisions that affect their lives. Our child safe policies, strategies and practices are inclusive of the needs of all children.

We have no tolerance for harm to children and take proactive steps to identify and manage any risk of harm to students in our school environments, including camps, excursions and online environments.

We take proactive steps to identify and manage any risk of harm to students in our care. Our school has a culture that encourages reporting and when concerns are raised, we treat them seriously and respond promptly and thoroughly. Our organisation uses child safe recruitment and induction policies and procedures and ensures all staff and volunteers are suitable and receive ongoing training in child safety.

We promote positive relationships between students and adults and between students and their peers. These relationships are based on trust and respect.

Diversity is respected and equity is upheld by recognising children with diverse needs and circumstances. Child safety is a shared responsibility. Every person in the school has an important role to play in promoting wellbeing and responding to safety concerns promptly and in line with our reporting policies. We have active Codes of Conduct for all people on the campus which make clear our rules and expectations.

Our school is committed to regular reviews of our child safe policies and procedures. We seek input from the school community to inform our reviews. Our child safe policies and procedures provide guidance and clarity to staff, volunteers, parents and children about how to prevent and respond to child safety issues and are available both online and in physical format for ease of access.
